

NEXT YEARS FIELDS AND CONCERNS


- Next year as fields close with development need to decide how far East we want to

RECRUITMENT FROM THE WEB

- Open recruitment from the website will be from March I through August 31.
 - a. Current Members can sponsor new members all year long.
 - I. New members are under probation for the first year and cannot sponsor a new member.
- Still requires meeting with a Board Officer and an initial interview.
- Will require attending an Orientation Class prior to hunting on Club property.
 - a. Class held on first Saturday of each month (as required).
 - b. All members are encouraged to attend but not required.

NEW ORIENTATION PROCESS

- I. All new members will be required to attend an Orientation Class prior to hunting on Club property. New members will be defined as those members joining after March 1, 2019.
- 2. Classes will be held on the first Saturday of each month at the Trap Club starting at 9:00 am. Class should take about one hour, depending on questions asked.
- 3. There will be at least one Berthoud Gun Club Officer, one Hunting Committee member, one Fishing Committee member and one Trap Club Officer to lead the Orientation and answer questions.
- 4. It is encouraged that all Club members attend one class to keep up on Club rules, changes and to refresh their memory of Club rules.
- 5. Any Club member placed on probation will be required to attend an Orientation Class prior to using Club property for any purpose.
