General Rules and Information

1. The lakes have very steep banks and drop off fast within three (3) or four (4) feet of waterline. Be careful if wading in these areas. And be very mindful if there are children in the area.

Fishing Rules

Fishing Rules, sizes and limits can also be found on the back of your Rearview Mirror Placard.

- Do not import any fish into the lakes, except minnows that will be used as bait.
 When finished with your minnows do not dispose of unused minnows in the lakes.
- 2. All Bass under 15 inches must be returned to the water immediately and unharmed. The limit for Bass is two (2) fish per day per angler.

- 3. All Walleye under 15 inches must be returned to the water immediately and unharmed. The limit for Walleye is two (2) fish per day per angler.
- 4. All Crappie under 10 inches must be returned to the water immediately and unharmed. The limit for Crappie is four (4) fish per day per angler.

Hunting:

Dove

- 1. All State Regulations must be adhered to.
- 2. No hunt dove after the Wednesday before the opening of Teal Season, typically the second Saturday of September.
- 3. Berthoud Gun Club members only, guests are not allowed to hunt Dove on the property.

Duck

- 1. All State Regulations must be adhered to.
- 2. No "sky busting". Sky busting is defined as shooting birds over your blind that are too high to be able to successfully kill a bird.
- 3. "Pass shooting" is not allowed. Pass shooting is defined as shooting at ducks over decoys that do not appear to have any intention of landing in YOUR set of decoys or do not have their wings set for landing in YOUR set of decoys.

Goose

- 1. All State Regulations must be adhered to.
- 2. No "sky busting". Sky busting is defined as shooting geese over your blind that are too high to be able to successfully kill a bird.
- 3. "Pass shooting" is not allowed. Pass shooting is defined as shooting at geese over decoys that do not appear to have any intention of landing in YOUR set of decoys or do not have their wings set for landing in YOUR set of decoys.

Teal

- 1. All State Regulations must be adhered to.
- 2. No "sky busting". Sky busting is defined as shooting ducks over your blind that are too high to be able to successfully kill a bird.
- 3. "Pass shooting" is not allowed. Pass shooting is defined as shooting at ducks over decoys that do not appear to have any intention of landing in YOUR set of decoys or do not have their wings set for landing in YOUR set of decoys.

Turkey

1. Turkey hunting is not allowed at this time.

Mule Deer and Whitetail Deer

1. Hunting Mule Deer and Whitetail deer is not allowed at this time.

Camping

- 1. Camp in designated areas only.
- 2. Remove all trash.
- 3. No dumping of "Black Water" anywhere on the properties leased and operated by the Berthoud Gun Club.

Trap Shooting

1. Follow all rules of the Trap Club.
